The outcomes indicate that respective key items of Affect of Service, Library as Place and Information Control are willingness to help users and giving users individual attention, quiet space for individual activities, and easy-to-use access tools that allows me to find things on my own, a library website enabling me to locate information on my own and making information easily accessible for independent use, respectively.
