Abstract

The desire of human beings and the goal of government policy basically have a common point, i.e., the better life in happiness. However, the common point composed of multi-criteria from objective and subjective living causes difficulty in decision making. This research applies the fuzzy set extensions of dominance-based rough set approach (FSE-DRSA) on the better life in happiness defined by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development's (OECD). The proposed application discloses the important criteria that can raise the living standard. The results show that dwellings with basic facilities, employment rate, long-term unemployment rate, and life satisfaction are identified as significant in the top-ten level.
